**Attention: Campus CB1, NÜRTINGEN** (not Geislingen)

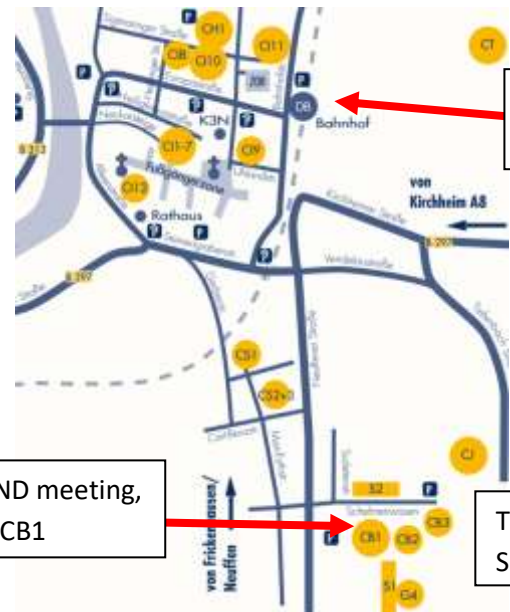
Nürtingen is located in Baden-Württemberg, in the south of Germany. Nearest airport is Stuttgart.

a) By public transport from Stuttgart International **Airport**: Take the S2 from the Airport to Nürtingen

b) By **train** to **Nürtingen Bahnhof**:

From **Nürtingen Main station** with a **local train (WEG = Württembergische Eisenbahn Gesellschaft)** to **Nürtingen-Roßdorf**, from there **bus No 183** to bus stop **Schelmenwasen**. Alternatively you'll take the bus 183 directly at the main station in Nürtingen.
